

CONVERSION PROCESS AT ELSE






Our products being produced at our Çorlu facility with ith a closed area of 42,000 m² and an open area of 80,000 m², totaling 122,000 m².

By recycling; We preserve 27.5 million m³ of water, ensuring sustainable resources for the future.






20/1 Single jersey : Single jersey fabrics made with 20/1 yarn count are typically heavier and thicker compared to those made with finer yarn counts. They are commonly used in producing T-shirts, casual tops, and other garments that require more substantial weight and durability.



30/1 Single jersey : Single jersey fabrics made with 30/1 yarn count are finer and lighter compared to those made with 20/1 yarn count. They are often used in creating lightweight, comfortable garments, including premium T-shirts, layering tops, and clothing for warmer weather.







30/2 Single Jersey: "30/2 Single Jersey" signifies a knit fabric made with yarn that has a count of 30 hanks per pound and is composed of two strands twisted together. This type of fabric would typically be finer and smoother compared to single jersey fabrics with a lower yarn count, making it suitable for lightweight garments like T-shirts, tank tops, and other apparel items. The two-ply construction also contributes to added strength and durability in the fabric.





36/1 Single Jersey: "36/1 Single Jersey" signifies a knit fabric made with yarn that has a count of 36 hanks per pound and is composed of a single single yarn strand. This type of fabric would typically be finer and smoother compared to single jersey fabrics with a lower yarn count, making it suitable for lightweight garments like T-shirts, tank tops, and other apparel items.

Knitting technique: Single Plate

Width Range (cms): 160 - 175

Weight Range (gr/m²): 90 - 135

40/1 Single Jersey: "40/1 Single Jersey" signifies a knit fabric made with yarn that has a count of 40 hanks per pound and is composed of a single yarn strand. This type of fabric would typically be finer and smoother compared to single jersey fabrics with lower yarn counts, making it suitable for lightweight garments like T-shirts, tank tops, and other apparel items. It may also have a softer hand feel due to the finer yarn.

Knitting technique: Single Plate Width Range (cms): 155 - 170 Weight Range (gr/m²): 85 - 130

Areas of use: Casual Wear, Activewear, Undergarments, Loungewear, Children's Wear, Fashion and Everyday Clothing, Promotional Clothing, Medical Wear, Seasonal Clothing (Summer Wear), Maternity Wear



3 THREAD FLEECE & TERRY

3 Thread Fleece: 3 thread fleece fabric is typically made from synthetic fibers such as polyester or a blend of polyester and other materials. It is knitted using a specialized technique that involves three separate yarns. This construction method enhances the fabric's thickness and warmth. Similar to 2 thread fleece, 3 thread fleece fabric has a plush, fuzzy texture on one or both sides. This texture provides warmth and softness, making it comfortable to wear in colder weather. 3 thread fleece knitted fabric is commonly used in cold-weather clothing items such as jackets, hoodies, pullovers, and blankets. It provides insulation and moisture-wicking properties, making it suitable for outdoor and active wear.







3 THREAD FLEECE & TERRY

3 Thread Terry : 3 thread terry fabric is knitted using a technique where three separate yarns are looped into the fabric, creating a pile or looped texture on one or both sides. This construction method enhances the fabric's thickness and softness. Terry knit fabric has a plush, textured surface, similar to the texture of towels or bathrobes. The addition of a third thread further enhances its thickness and absorbency. 3 thread terry knitted fabric is commonly used for towels, bathrobes, washcloths, and other items requiring absorbency and softness. It is also used in casual apparel such as sweatpants and hoodies.
